

Original proposals

- Name
- Underpinning
- Domains
- Approval system
- Reflection
- Audit



What's staying the same?

- Cycle duration
- Points requirements for all registrants, including need for interactive points
- Specialty requirements remain same
- Will still need to plan learning for cycle
- Peer review for optoms, TPs and CLOs

Consultation

- 12 weeks from May to August 2020
- Mixed methods approach
- 484 responses to survey from variety of stakeholders, including approvers



 In-depth interviews and focus groups

Feedback

- Broadly positive, with little negative impacts foreseen
- Changes to name (95%) and domains (83%) were seen as having the most positive impact on registrants, with changes to the approval process following closely behind (67%)
- Feeling that clear communication of change and support to adapt will be key to success

Potential amendments



- Shorter CPD sessions being eligible for points
- 'Non-approved' CPD having fewer restrictions as to design
- ...extension of peer review?

Still to do...

- Finer detail of changes to processes underpinning the scheme – audit, MyCET system development, approval for 'provisional' providers – throughout 2021
- Policies being tweaked and will be communicated to providers in January 2021
- Continuing opportunities to collaborate and contribute
